

Supply Lists for Students:

Grades 1-2 Humanities

___ yellow folder with pockets

___ composition book (primary or wide-ruled)

___ pencils & sharpener

___ 8+ pack of colored pencils (recommend Prismacolor or Prismacolor Scholar)

___ glue stick

___ ring or mini-binder for memory cards

___ pack of 3X5 cards & Ziploc bag to keep them in

___ watercolors & brush (inexpensive set is fine, and watercolor pencils are fine, too)

___ markers

___ pencil box or similar item to hold supplies

___ scissors (age-appropriate)

___ sketchbook, 5 ½ by 8 ½ is great. Larger is fine too. (Paper should be heavy enough to handle wet media – at least 75lb) **Grade 2: you may continue using the sketchbook from last year, if you like**

- Michael's carries one by Strathmore for Mixed Media (300 Series) that's just under \$10 (and you can use a coupon from the website for 50% off). The paper weight is 90 lbs.
- Dick Blick sells the same one for only \$5.20, but you'll have to add shipping.

___ **Optional:** magnetic board w/ alphabet letters OR letter tiles from a game, such as Bananagrams or Scrabble. *(These are for the optional activities in the phonics books and will only be used at home.)*

***You can keep a binder at home for filing completed work, but anything needed for classwork will be placed in the yellow homework folders, or will be done in the composition and sketch books. This will minimize the weight of your child's backpack. 😊**
